

Thank you for registering for Eagle Care this year! Whether you are signed up for one day a week or all five, the Eagle Care team is looking forward to welcoming your child into a safe, secure, and fun environment. We are delighted that school is back in session, and we will run Eagle Care in accordance to our school's reopening guidelines.

Here are a few things to know as we approach the start of a new year:

*If you arrive prior to 3:30, you will follow your building's general dismissal process.

1. **ALL** students preschool-8th grade will be checked out at the same location as shown on this video:

YOU MUST REMAIN IN YOUR CAR, YOU MUST SHOW YOUR PARENT ID OR DRIVERS LICENSE, AND YOU MUST BE ON THE AUTHORIZED PICK UP LIST!

2. If you are the parent of a preschool-4th grader, your student(s) will be escorted to your car where you check them out. If you are the parent of a 5th-8th grader, after you check your student out, you will pull forward to the last door on the right, **Door 3-4**, where your child will exit the building. There will be a sidewalk sign indicating where to park and wait in your vehicle.

3. While many of your kids will pack a fruit snack for the school day, we highly recommend that you send an additional snack and refillable water bottle for Eagle Care. ****This is a significant change for 5th-8th graders as the Cafe will no longer be open.***

4. Please send a book or simple activity that your child can manage independently.

Our general daily schedule for preschool-4th grade is as follows:

3:30-4:00 - Students will be checked into Eagle Care cohorts in designated classrooms. Quiet Time: restroom, wash hands, eat snacks, play/read independently.

4:00-5:00 - Playground, weather permitting; otherwise we will play in our Eagle Care cohorts, in designated classrooms

5:00-5:30 - Remaining students will wait for their rides at physically distanced spots in the building, near the car line exit

5:30 - You must pick up your student by 5:30.

5th-8th grade will be operated more like a study hall. School-issued technology is permitted and will be monitored by Eagle Care staff.
